3. What is a toxic nodule of thyroid? How will you investigate and treat such a case? 2+(3+5)
4. Describe the anatomy of submandibular gland. Discuss the treatment of submandibular sialadenitis. Mention complications of its surgery. 3+5+2
5. What are the various levels of lymph nodes in Neck? How do you stage Head and Neck cancers? Enumerate the various types of neck dissections. 3+4+3
